

# Australian Teak

The Australian Teak is a hardy native teak ideal for larger street locations due to its attractive, small, white flowers and thick foliage for shade coverage. The new limb growth appears as an attractive bronze colour during the summer months before turning a glossy green.

Australian Teak is known for producing a strong and durable timber that is used for cabinetry, boat building and residential construction.

	<b>Leaf</b>	Glossy green leaf with many smaller parts joined to a central stem with serrated edges
	<b>Bark</b>	Scaly grey
	<b>Flowers</b>	Small and white
	<b>Fruit Pod</b>	Brown spiky capsule
