

Dwarf Apple Gum

With large white flowers and a gnarled appearance, the Dwarf Apple Gum is an easy to care for tree with great character. Establishing within three years and being moderately long-lived, this dwarf species is an excellent choice for locations with overhead constraints like power lines. This hardy tree enjoys sunny locations and is drought tolerant making it a superb street tree.
