

# Dwarf Lilly Pilly

Naturally found along rainforest creek lines on the east coast of New South Wales, this small tree is known for its long-lasting, deep purple, Winter fruit and bright, lush juvenile foliage. A hardy, dense shrubby tree, in Summer the Dwarf Lilly Pilly erupts in fluffy white flowers. This species is easy to maintain and will brighten the domestic streetscape.
