

Fried Egg Plant

This small tree grows in a broad round shape, its glossy green leaves and vibrant flower display makes it an excellent choice for street plantings. The Fried Egg Plant owes its name to the large white flowers with a yellow centre that land 'sunny side up' when they drop. Taking a while to establish, it prefers well-drained moist soils, and will need a regular water during hot Summer months.
