

Lasiandra

The Lasiandra, also known as 'Princess Flower', is an evergreen tree that can be grown into either a shrub or small tree making it a versatile street tree. It is known for its vibrant purple flowers that bloom from summer to autumn.

It naturally enjoys a warm humid climate, large amounts of sunshine and is susceptible to frost and drought but has adapted well to the local climate. It is a robust, thickly growing shade tree well-suited to Parramatta.
