## **Port Wine Magnolia**

This vibrant exotic shrub is known for its small flowers which produce a heady fruity scent likened to banana and vintage port. Blooming from Spring to Summer, flowers begin as a deep purple colour and transition to a creamy white. Native to south west China, this species prefers a sunny position and needs a little help with regular watering in dry periods.
