

Tuckeroo



The Tuckeroo is a tough, hardy, native evergreen tree. It is durable, resilient and able to adapt to harsh and ever changing conditions. The Tuckeroo's thick lush foliage provides deep shade and is accentuated by the smooth grey bark, small yellow/green flowers and orange/yellow seed pods. The root system is non-invasive making them perfect for streetscape conditions.

An attractive tree, the Tuckeroo adds colour to suburban streets and is commonly used in streetscapes across Sydney.

 Origin	Australia
 Typical height	7-12m
 Typical width	5-8m
 Leaf	Dark green, thick and leathery. Oval-like shape
 Bark	Smooth, pale to dark grey
 Flowers	Very small yellow and green flowers
 Fruit Pod	Orange/yellow seed pods
