









Urbanite Ash

The Urbanite Ash is a versatile tree and can be used in streets, parks and gardens. Producing yellow-green flowers in Spring, the luscious, dark-green, dense foliage provides plenty of shade in the Summer before turning a beautiful bronze in Autumn. The leaves drop in Winter. The distinctive grey-brown bark transitions from smooth when young to deeply furrowed as the tree matures. The Urbanite Ash adapts well to most soil conditions, and has a high frost and moderate drought tolerance.
