Application fee

The \$40 application fee can be paid by credit card over the phone by calling 02 9806 5050. Cheques or money orders should be made out to City of Parramatta.

Reviewable decisions

Access applicants

You can ask for a review of any of the following decisions (or a combination) under section 80 of the GIPA Act:

- a decision that an application is not a valid access application
- a decision to transfer an access application to another agency, as an agency-initiated transfer
- a decision to refuse to deal with an access application (including a decision that is deemed to have been made because the City of Parramatta did not decide your application on time)
- a decision to provide access or to refuse to provide access to information
- decision that government information is not held by the City of Parramatta
- a decision that information applied for is already available to you
- a decision to refuse to confirm or deny that information is held by the City of Parramatta
- a decision to defer the provision of access to information
- a decision to provide access to information in a particular way (or a decision not to provide access in the way requested by you)
- a decision to impose a processing charge or to require an advance deposit
- a decision to refuse a reduction in a processing charge
- a decision to refuse to deal further with your access application because you failed to pay an
- advance deposit within the time required for payment
- a decision to include information in the City of Parramatta's disclosure log despite your objections (or a decision that you were not entitled to object).

Third parties

If you are not the access applicant, but instead a third party who was consulted in respect of a GIPA application, you can ask for a review of a decision to provide access to information contrary to your objections (section 80(d) of the GIPA Act).

As a third party, you can also ask for a review of a decision to include information in the City of Parramatta's disclosure log despite your objections (section 80(m) of the GIPA Act).
