WHO CAN REPORT?	<b>Anyone can report including:</b> A parent or carer, child, community member or any City of Parramatta Worker (including agency staff, students on placement, volunteers, contracted service providers and Councillors).
WHAT TO REPORT	<ul> <li>Any child safety concerns including;</li> <li>Disclosure of abuse or harm; physical, sexual, emotional and neglect</li> <li>Allegations of abuse, suspicion of abuse and any observations that you feel might be abuse</li> <li>Any breach of Child Safe Code of Conduct, Councils Code of Conduct &amp; Child Safe Policy</li> <li>General safety or environmental concerns</li> </ul>
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HOW TO REPORT	Parents, carers, children and community members can report verbally face-to-face, by letter or phone or Email: childsafe@cityofparramatta.nsw.gov.au
WHO TO REPORT TO	Any City of Parramatta Worker
WHAT HAPPENS NEXT	A Child's immediate safety is a priority, and the child must be removed from any danger Incidents involving a child

	These must be <b>reported immediately to the City of Parramatta Child Safe triage team on 9806 5021 or via email childsafe@cityofparramatta.nsw.gov.au where the report will be triaged.</b>
	<ul> <li>Any suspected or known criminal offence must be reported immediately to NSW Police 000</li> <li>If reporting risk of significat ham (ROSH) – a report will be made to the Child Protection Helpline on 132 111 and or via Child Story MRG (nsw.gov.au)</li> <li>Support offered to the child, parent/carer, person who made the report, and or any affected City of Parramatta Worker.</li> </ul>
